

**Dear Colleagues,**

**It is officially confirmed, on the basis of PETA list, that Inglot Sp. z o.o. does not test cosmetic products on animals, holding thereby the status of Cruelty-Free Company.**

Should you take any actions in the EU market or deal with any customers from the EU, please be advised that the presented logo or "non-animal tested/ not tested on animals/ cruelty free" or similar, cannot be used in EU Member States. As you are probably aware, animal testing of cosmetic products and/or cosmetic ingredients is strictly prohibited in the European Union, according to cosmetic regulation (EC) 1223/2009. It concerns both cosmetics manufactured in the EU, or the imported ones. No company is allowed to advertise or state that their cosmetics are not tested on animals, because such claims are treated as unfair competition according to regulation (EC) 655/2013 and can be penalized.

Any cosmetic product that is sold in the EU market may not be tested on animals. Please be aware, that the regulations described above are closely overseen by the European Commission.

The attached logo may be used outside European Union for promotional purposes (social media/website). The logo cannot be placed on product packaging.
